1.Brief Summary of Research Methodology Course

This Report Of The Ten Days National Workshop on "Research Methodology for Research Scholars in Social Science" was organized by department of education ,saurashtra university,Rajkot, Sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi from 28th Feb. to 08th March 2016 in the Education Department, Saurashtra University, Rajkot (Gujarat).

The workshop was inaugurated by Dr.B.B.Ramanuj, Head, Education Department Saurashtra University. The workshop was attended by 30 participants. All of the participants who attended this workshop were research scholars were directly involved in research.

2. About the Research Methodology Course

2.1 Introduction

Research is the systematic and objective process of gathering, recording and analyzing data for taking appropriate & meaningful decisions. It connotes a patient study and scientific investment, wherein the researcher takes more careful look at data to discover all that could be known more deeply about the subject under study. Applied research facilitates managerial decision-making and reduces uncertainty. To keep pace with the recent advancement in any discipline, one has to be well versed with the latest developments in research methodology. Keeping in view the importance of research methodology, this course aims to explore the basic dimensions of research and the concomitant need for participants to rethink of research in the field of Education.

The workshop was designed to offer the participants with hands on approach to conduct research. On completion of the workshop, participants were likely to have developed the skills to review the literature, develop hypotheses, frame research design, identify sampling techniques and comprehend the role and relevance of the tools for data collection and analysis. The ten-day workshop exposed the participants to a brief theoretical input, followed by the field-work based on syndicates. The participants were expected to bring their research problem & data, if they had to work on during the workshop and at the end, they performed data analysis independently and made presentation before the class.

The main objectives of the Course were as follows:

- 2. To enhance the capability of doing quality research among Ph.D. Research Scholars and give them a thorough exposure to research methodology and data analysis with the help of SPSS.
