PRESS NOTE

University Grants Commission- New Delhi has made it mandatory to clear UGC NET/GSLET examination for recruitment as Assistant Professor in University PG Departments and Colleges. UGC is offering grants for organizing training Centres due to unavailability of eligible candidates.

Under the able guidance of Hon. Vice-Chancellor, Saurashtra University is conducting training classes for UGC NET. In June 2014, out of 1856 students appeared from Rajkot Centre across 57 subjects in NET, out of them 31 students cleared the examination. Of them 2 students qualified for JRF & APS while 29 qualified for APS. Subject wise they are: Sanskrit-04, Gujarati-03, Hindi-02, English-01, Management-04, Commerce-04, Education-04, Geography-02, Social Works-02, History-01, Economics-01, Physical Education-01, Library and Information Science-01, Electronics-01.

A merit list of students obtaining minimum qualified marks is prepared, of which only 1st 15% are declared passed. Thus, qualifying in this examination is a tough task.

Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and Coordinator of UGC NET Training centre Dr. Raja Kathad congratulates all successful candidates.

Next NET examination is going to be held on 28 December 2014 by CBSE. Opinions are invited from experts on whether the exams to be conducted as MCQ or Descriptive. Therefore, fair chances are for exams to be conducted by old pattern.

16.28% Result of Training Centre UGC-GSET 19th October 2014

University Grants Commission- funded UGC-NET/GSET preparation classes are organised by UGC-NET/GSET training center of Saurashtra University for the benefit of SC/ST/OBC/PH/Minority students as well as economically weak students belonging to open category. Classes for General studies Paper-1 are held at Academic Centre, while classes for Paper-2 & 3 are held at respective Departments.

Generally, result of UGC-NET/GSET is less than 5%. Success ratio is very low for this mandatory examination for appointment as Assistant Professor. Result of GSET for last 3-4 years haven't crossed mark of 5%. In recent GSET exam held on 19-10-2014 approximately 2700 students have appeared, of which 115 students have successfully cleared. Out of 86 students of Saurashtra University GSET training program, 14 have been successful. Of which, subject-wise result is as follows: Sanskrit(09), Gujarati(02), Economics(01), Chemistry(01). Thus, result of GSET training centre has been 16.28%, which is highest in the state of GUJARAT.




